



NATURAL INFUSION ART WITH KATE MCELROY



Be inspired by the beautiful gardens and stunning views of the River Lee from The Address Hotel. Local artist Kate McElroy invites you to explore the great outdoors and the gardens of The Address through your own creativity. You'll be introduced to the work of contemporary Irish artists and will then be invited to create their own artistic piece using organic materials from the natural world. Hand select your materials and be inspired by your environs, guided by Kate, to create your own artwork, infused with elements of the outdoors. All levels and abilities welcome, no previous experience necessary. All materials will be provided.

JELLY PLATE PRINTING WITH PAUL MCKENNA



Join local artist Paul McKenna to explore a fun and easy way to create mono-type prints without the use of a printing press. This workshop will allow you to experience a range of methods combining painting, stencilling surface masking and collage using jelly plates and slow drying acrylics. All levels and abilities welcome, no previous experience necessary. All materials will be provided.


STILL LIFE USING IMPASTO WITH PAUL MCKENNA



RECREATE A MASTERPIECE WITH PAUL MCKENNA



MONOPRINTING WITH AOIFE CLAFFEY



Mono printing is the process of making a print using 'mark making'. A mark can be a line, a dot, a scratch, a curve or even a thumbprint and so on. Join local artist Aoife Claffey to explore different tools and colours to create monoprints with water-based lino ink. A hands-on and fun technique suitable for all levels and abilities. All materials will be provided.

Aoife Claffey is a visual artist, living and working in Cork City. She creates installations combining film, printmaking and sound. She recently graduated with an MA in Art and Process from MTU Crawford College of Art and Design. She is a member of the Sample-Studios and Cork Printmakers. Her work is in the collection of Eli Lilly and has been featured in Bloomers Magazine #07: Emerging Female Artists.



MARK MAKING WITH PASTELS - LANDSCAPE DRAWING WITH SINÉAD BARRETT



Using the gardens and the wonderful vista of The Address Hotel, join local artist Sinead Barrett to build upon drawings, layer by layer. Through techniques of mark-making, layering and blending, you will create a beautiful and unique landscape drawing, learning how to create a pastel landscape and how to replicate a number of different visual textures using pastels.

Pastels are all about the layering of colours and building your image through those layers. This workshop will look at different techniques for pastels for beginners. Scumbling, Dragging, Layering and Blending to learn how to create your own landscape painting. All levels and abilities welcome, no previous experience necessary. All materials will be provided.

STREET ART WORKSHOP WITH AOIFE CLAFFEY
